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Trust Foundation

Ezelogs is built on a foundation of governed construction intelligence—where technology assists and humans decide.

Authoritative Records

Single source of truth for configured data domains. Clear write governance and audit trails. Integration authority boundaries defined.

Human Governance

AI assists with recommendations. Humans approve all significant decisions. Every action is traceable with source documentation.

Tenant Isolation

Multi-tenant architecture with strict tenant-level data isolation. Users belong to specific tenants with configuration and integration isolation.

Role-Based Access

Defined permission sets with specific action entitlements. Project-scoped role assignments with audit logging.

Human-Governed Intelligence

All AI-assisted features in Ezelogs operate under human governance:

Principle	Implementation
Human Approval	Recommendations require human confirmation before action
Transparency	Reasoning and sources are visible for every recommendation
Override	Users can reject or modify AI suggestions
Audit	All decisions are recorded with full traceability

AI Boundaries

AI Can

- Suggest actions with context
- Identify patterns and anomalies
- Prioritize attention items
- Draft content for review

AI Cannot

- Execute without human approval
- Make autonomous decisions
- Write to system of record alone
- Publish without review
